DETAILS

Traditionally the Monday and Tuesday of Thanksgiving week at Trinity are community/family building days with all school bowling, Snow Village and Mini Course Day. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we are unable to enjoy any of these traditional Trinity activities.

We have instead opted for Two Virtual Days to prepare our families for any potential school shutdowns due to the rising cases in Racine and the family gatherings and events that many are still choosing to attend. **These days will provide you and your student the opportunity to trial run/practice your family's plan that we had asked each family to have ready at the beginning of the school year.**

Virtual Day Requirements -

Students log-in to google classroom by 9:00am and respond to the opening assignment or attendance question. This documents attendance that is required by DPI for verification. Parents in K3, K4 and K5 will receive an email from their child's teacher.

The student will then complete each assignment by the end of day, 4pm. Homework will be due by 9am the following day unless otherwise assigned. Missing or late assignments are graded at the same levels as in-person assignments.

Students who have questions regarding an assignment can email the teacher or request parents to help with the communication. *(For longer Virtual days off due to required COVID isolation, a Zoom will be set up by the classroom teacher for questions and discuss progress.)*
