Traditionally the Monday and Tuesday of Thanksgiving week at Trinity are community/family building days with all school bowling, Snow Village and Mini Course Day. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we are unable to enjoy any of these traditional Trinity activities.

Students who have questions regarding an assignment can email the teacher or request parents to help with the communication. (For longer Virtual days off due to required COVID isolation, a Zoom will be set up by the classroom teacher for questions and discuss progress.)
